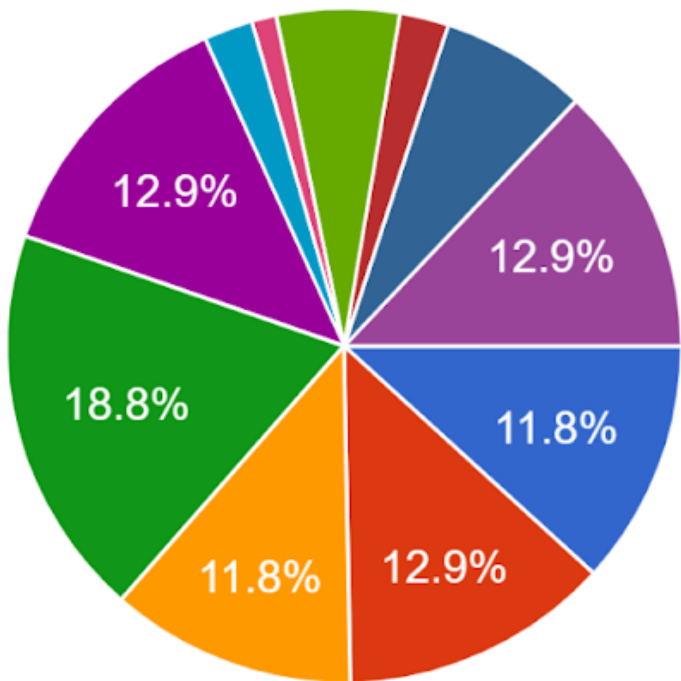

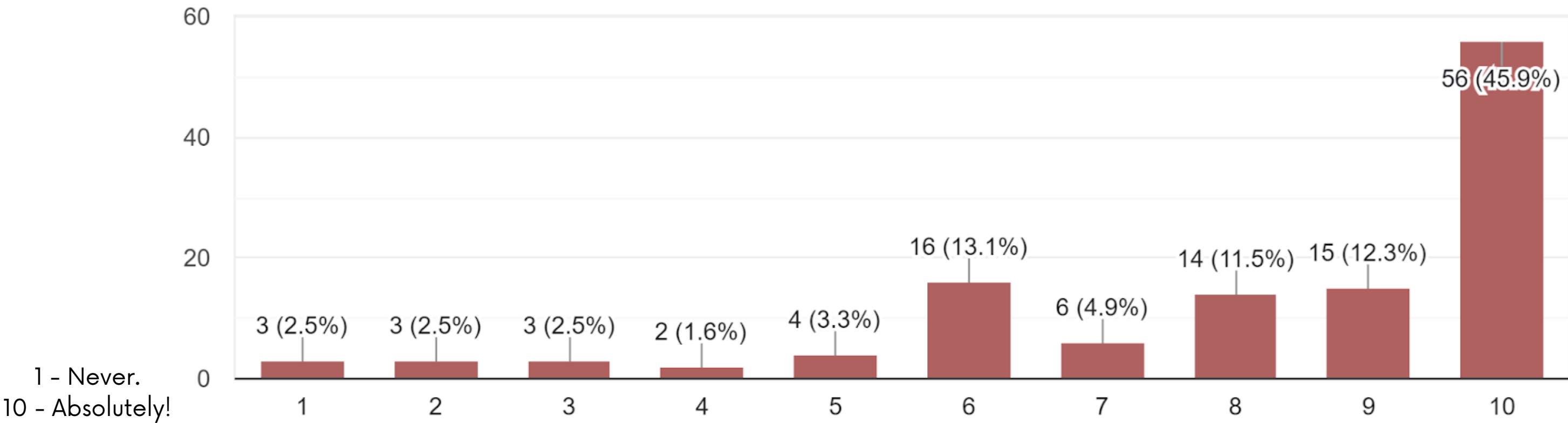

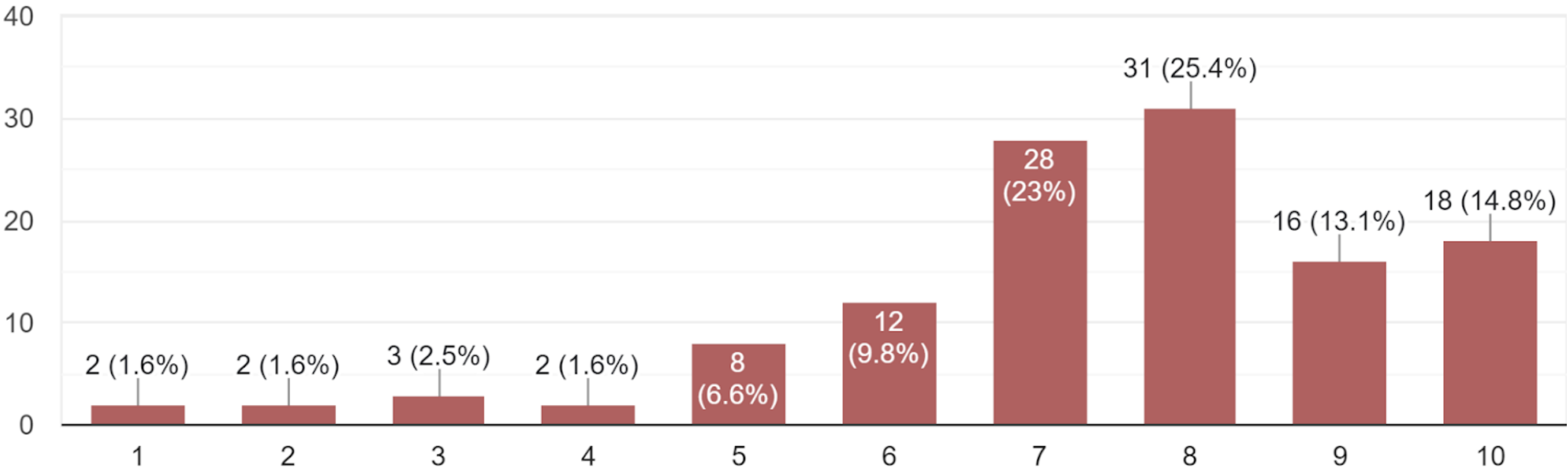

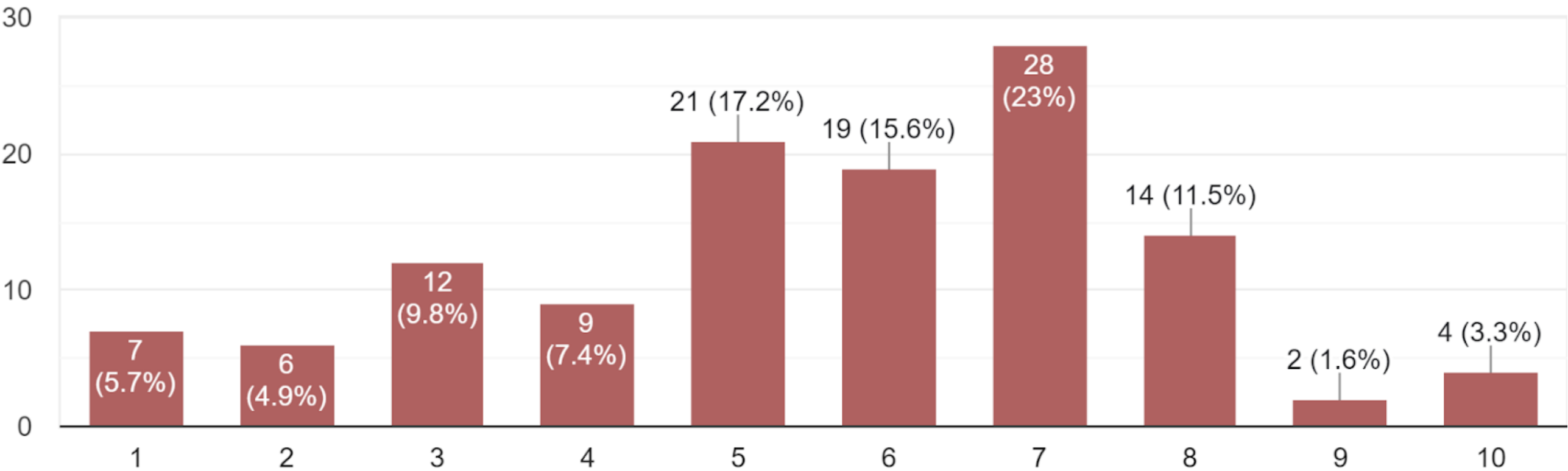

Is the course material difficult (too much)?

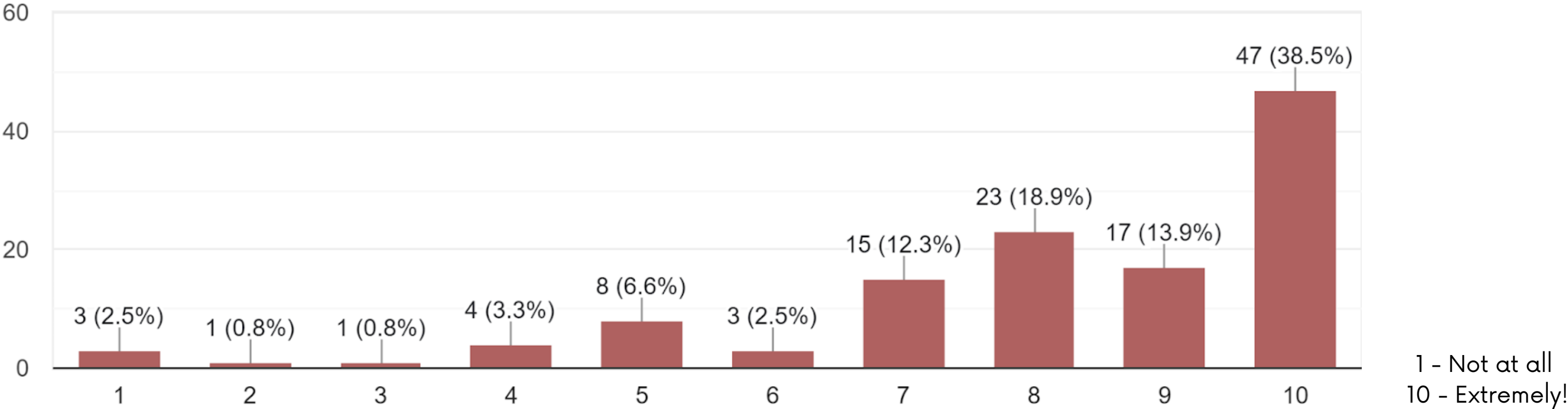

Is the course presented/taught in an interesting way?

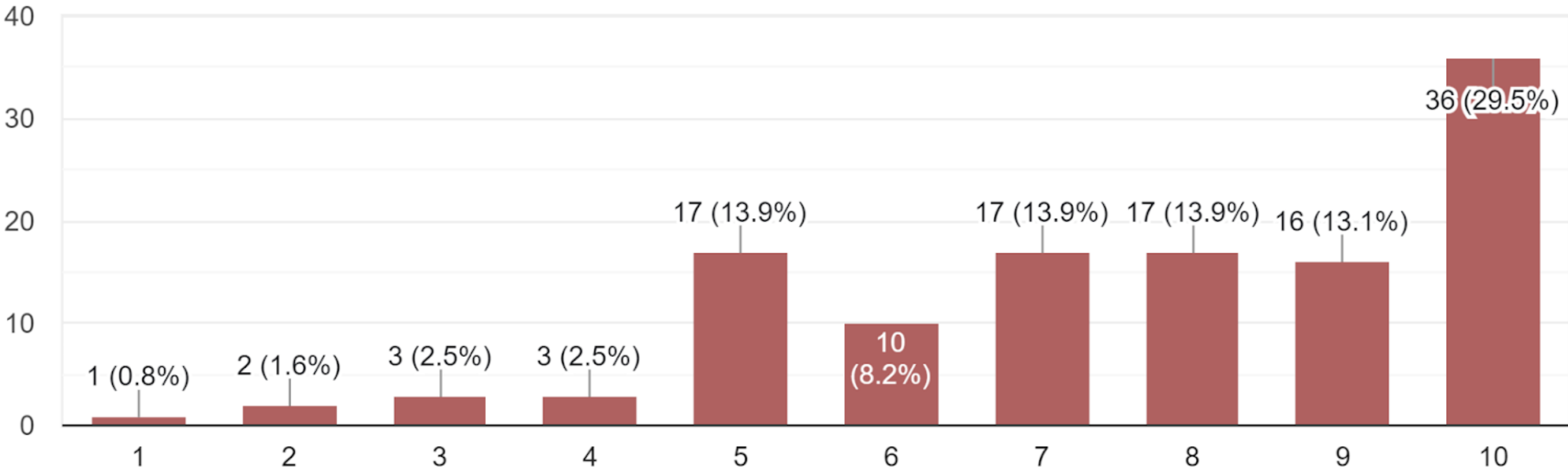

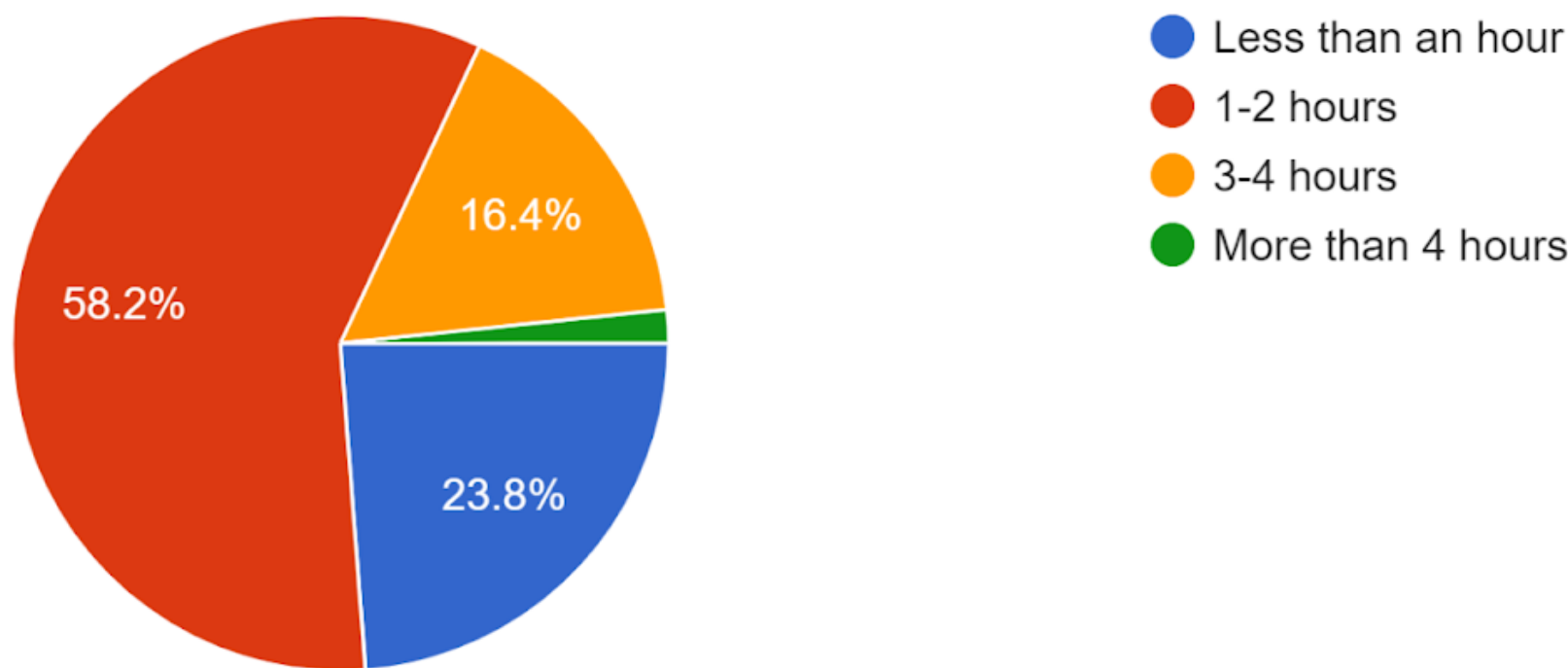

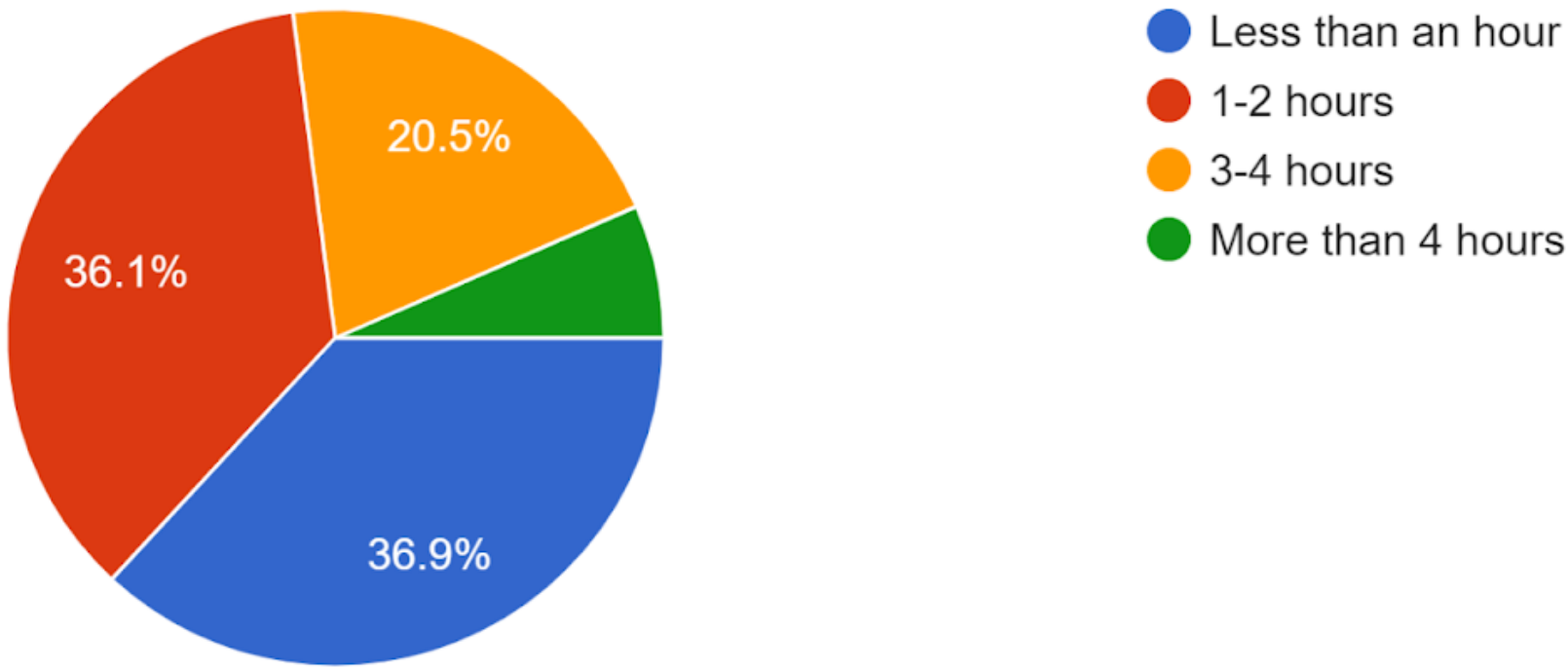
On average, how many hours a week did you spend on readings for this course?

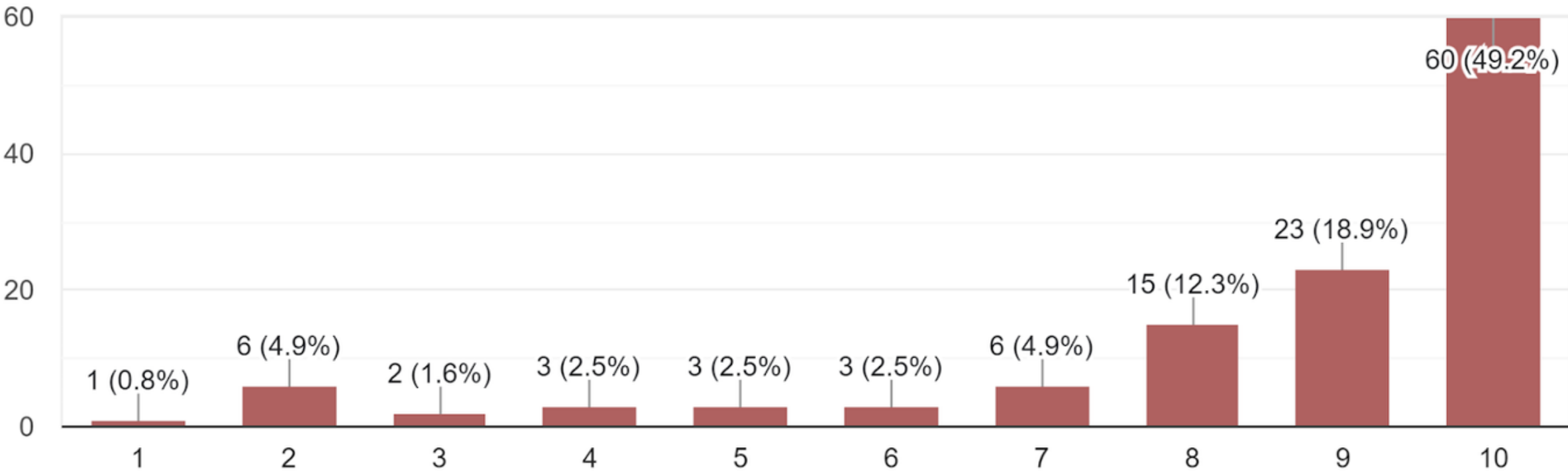
On average, how many hours a week did you spend on written or presentation assignments for this course?

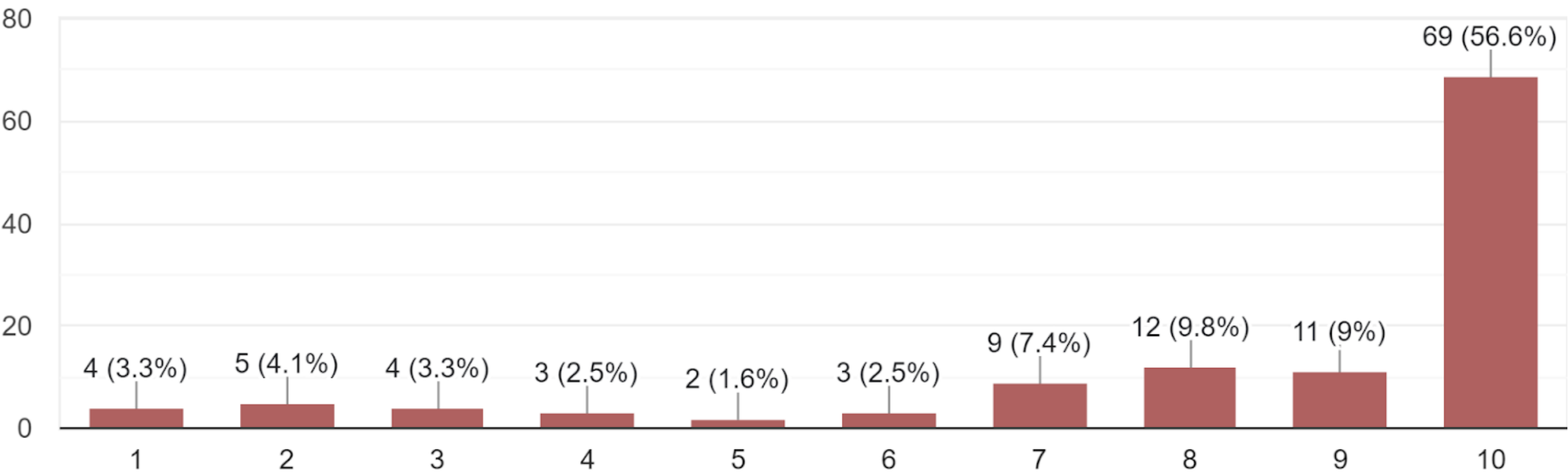

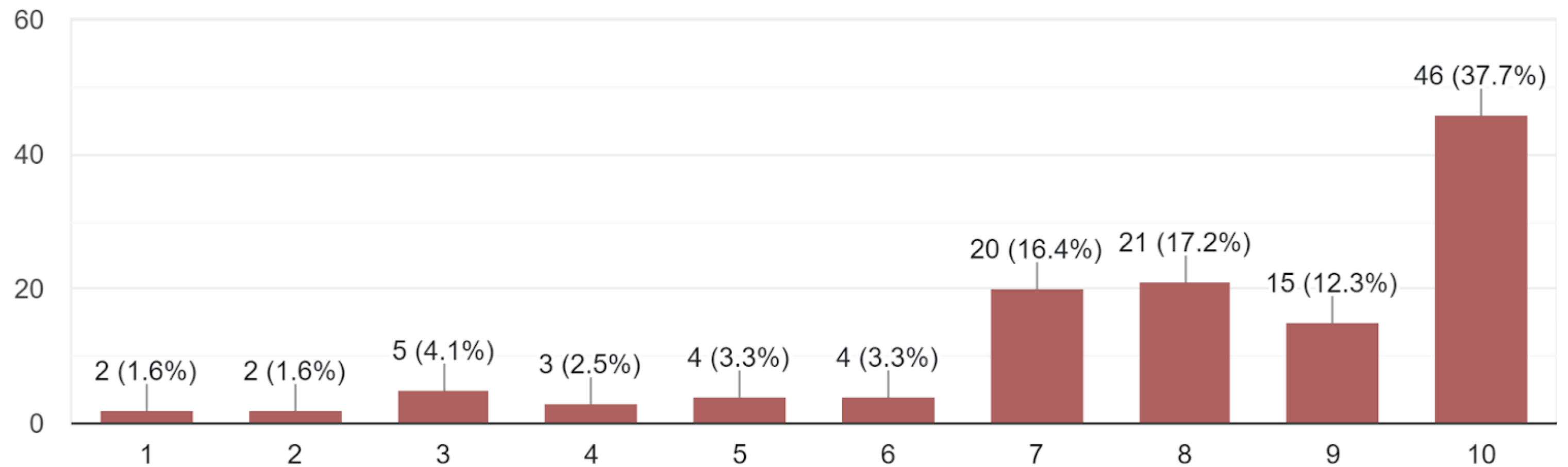

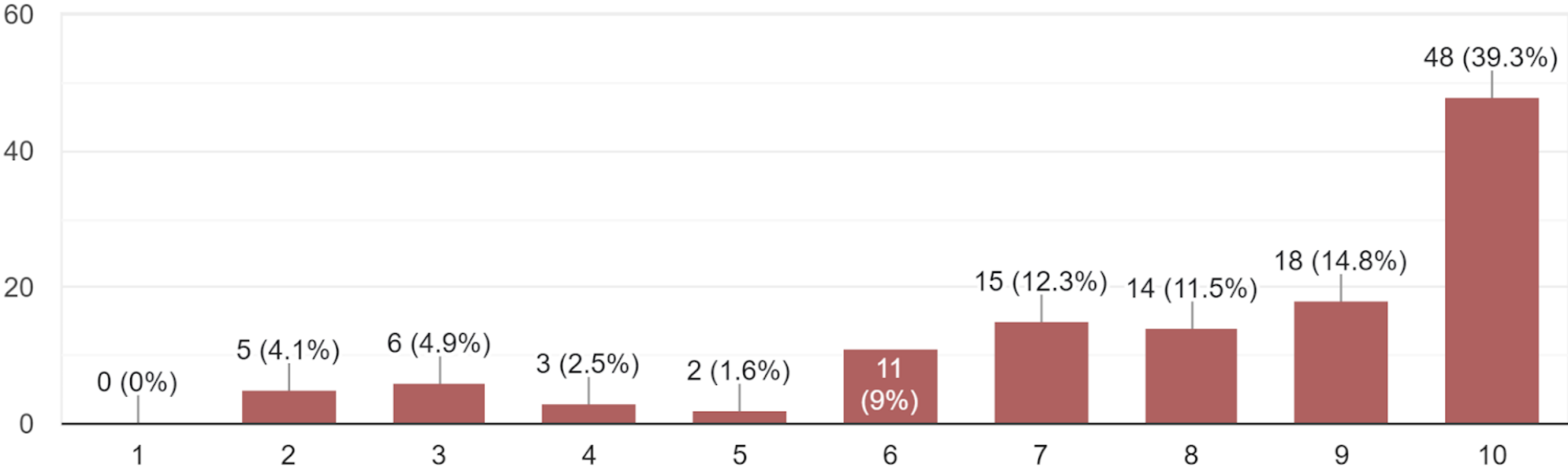

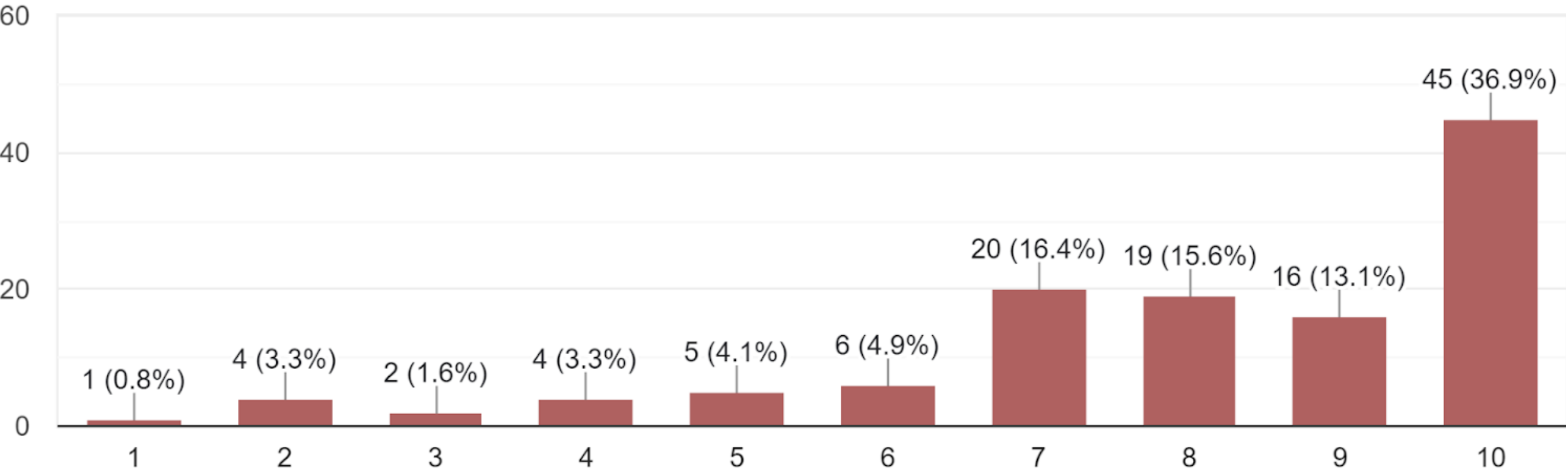

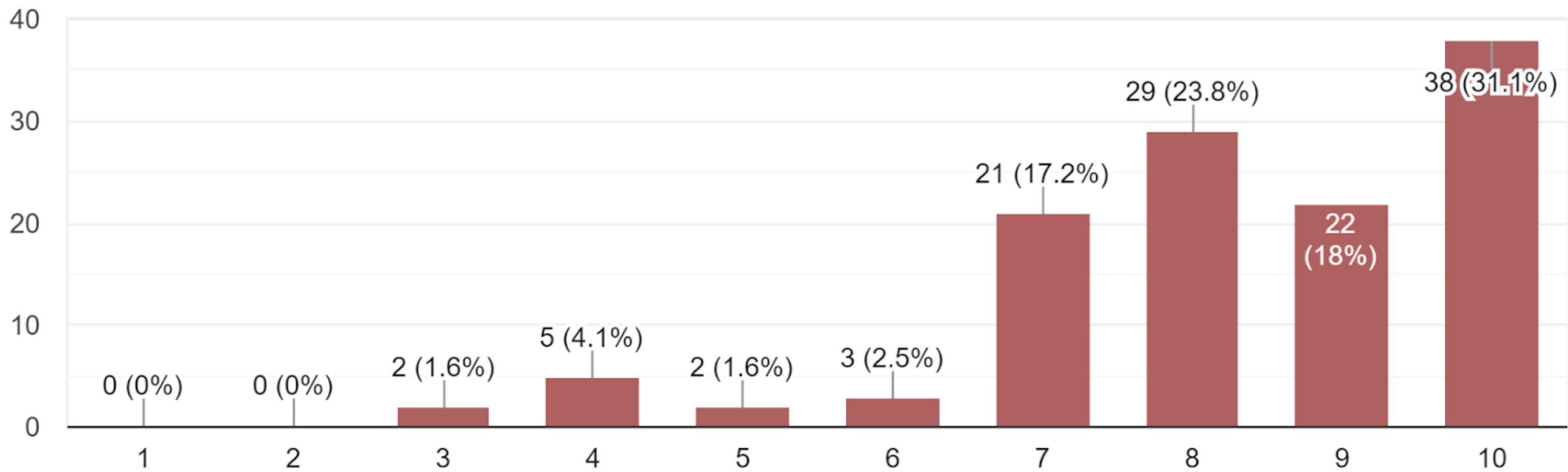

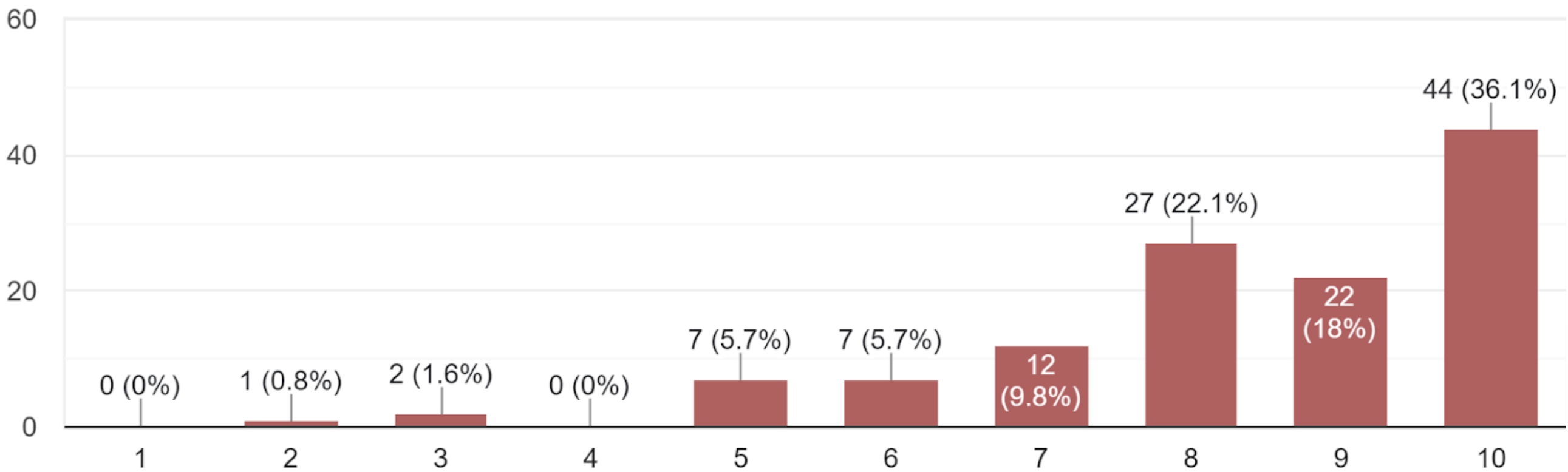

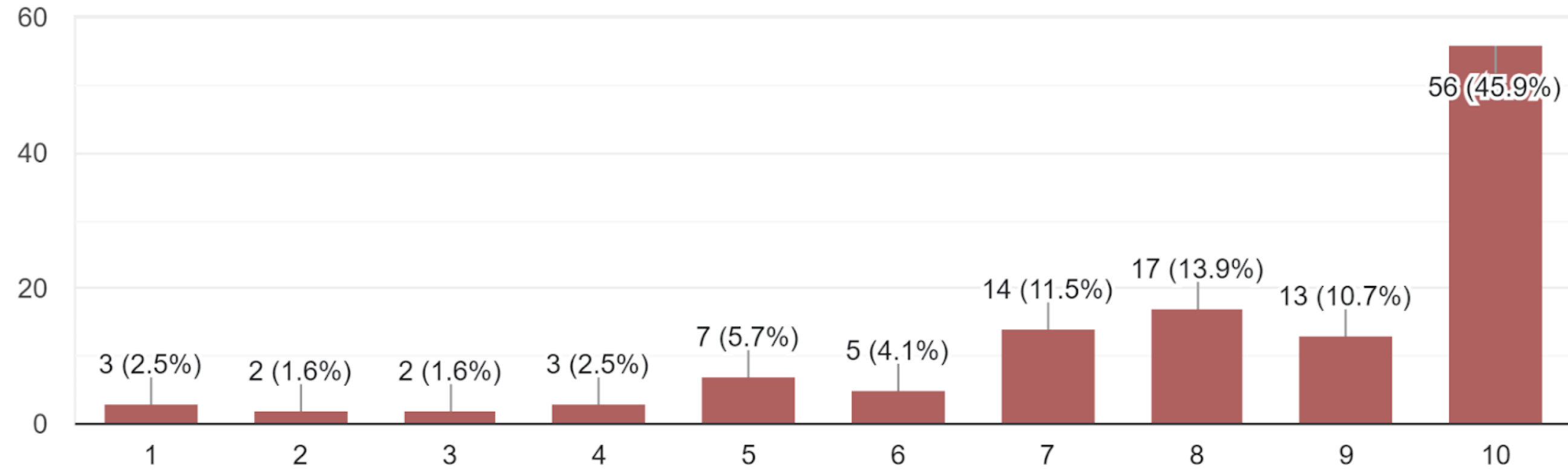

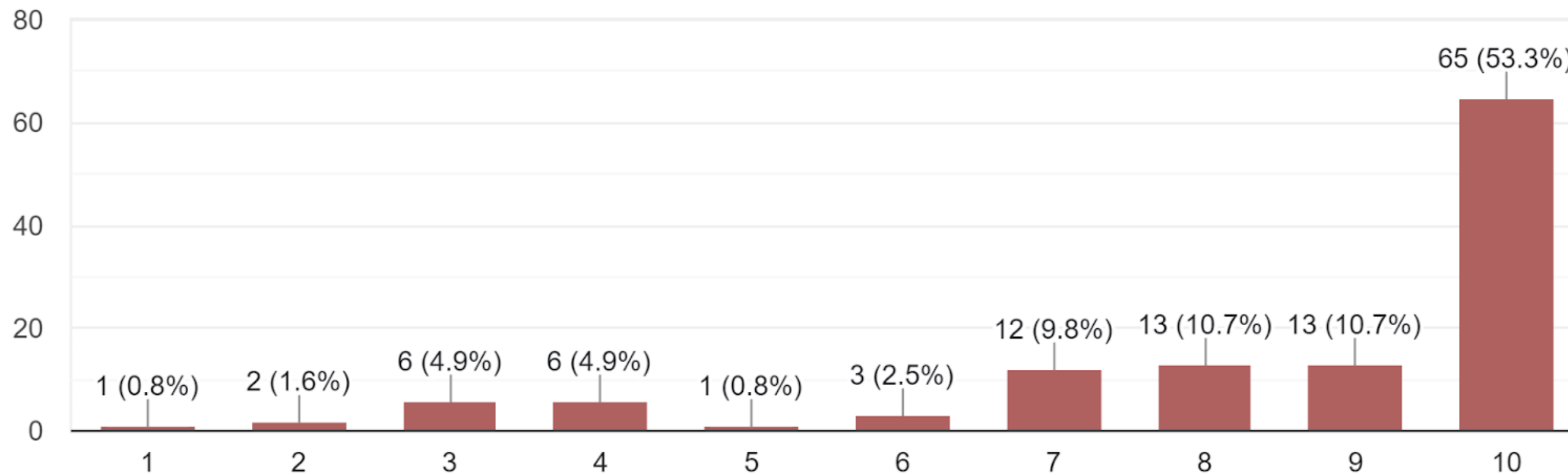

Giving clear and helpful feedback

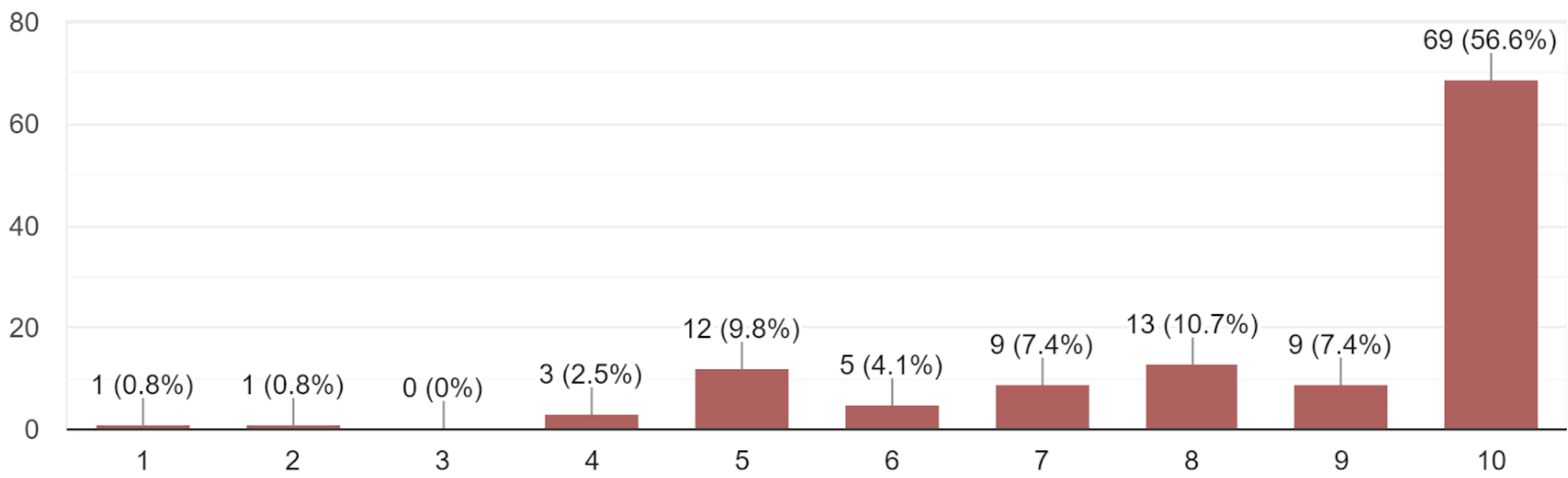

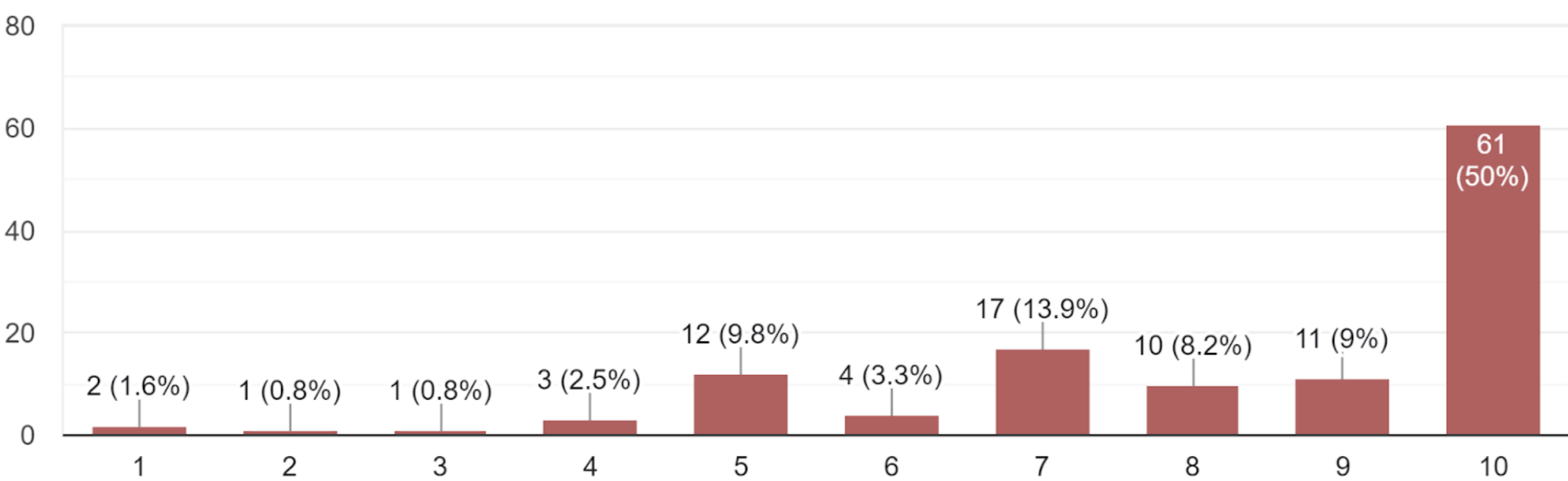


1 - Poor (They were always gone or busy.)

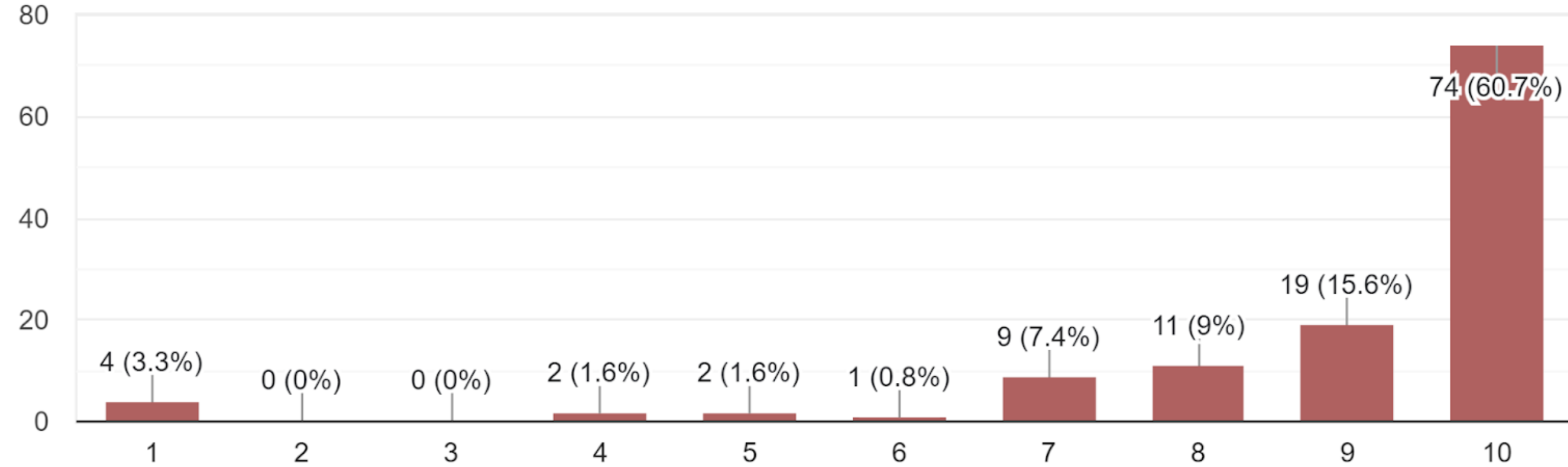

Encouraging students to ask/answer questions in class

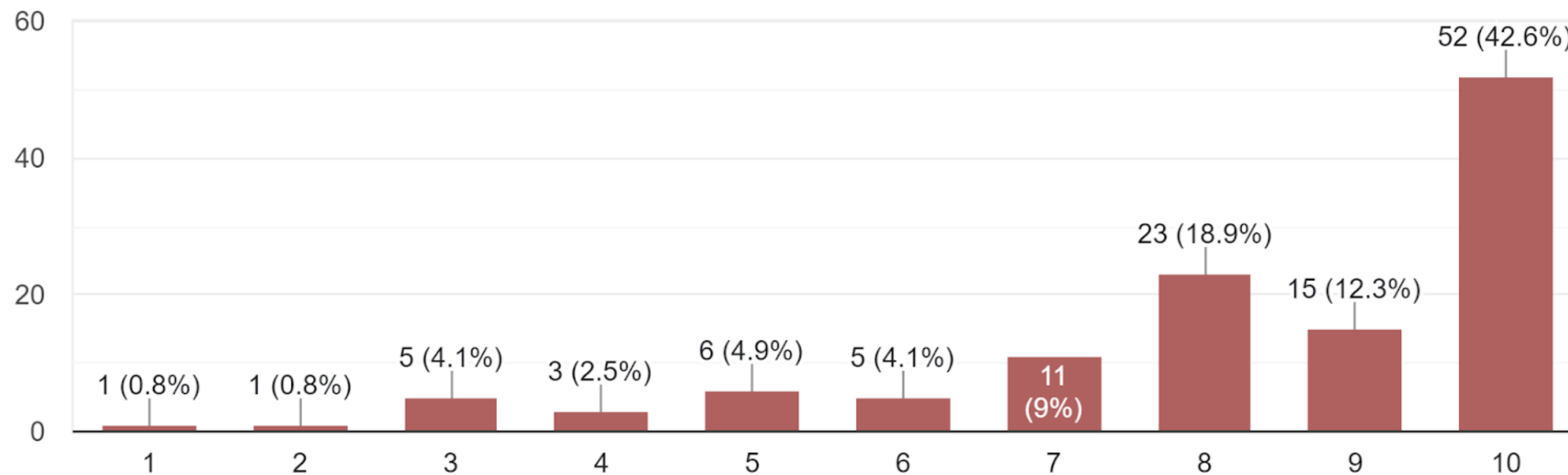

Making the material interesting and engaging

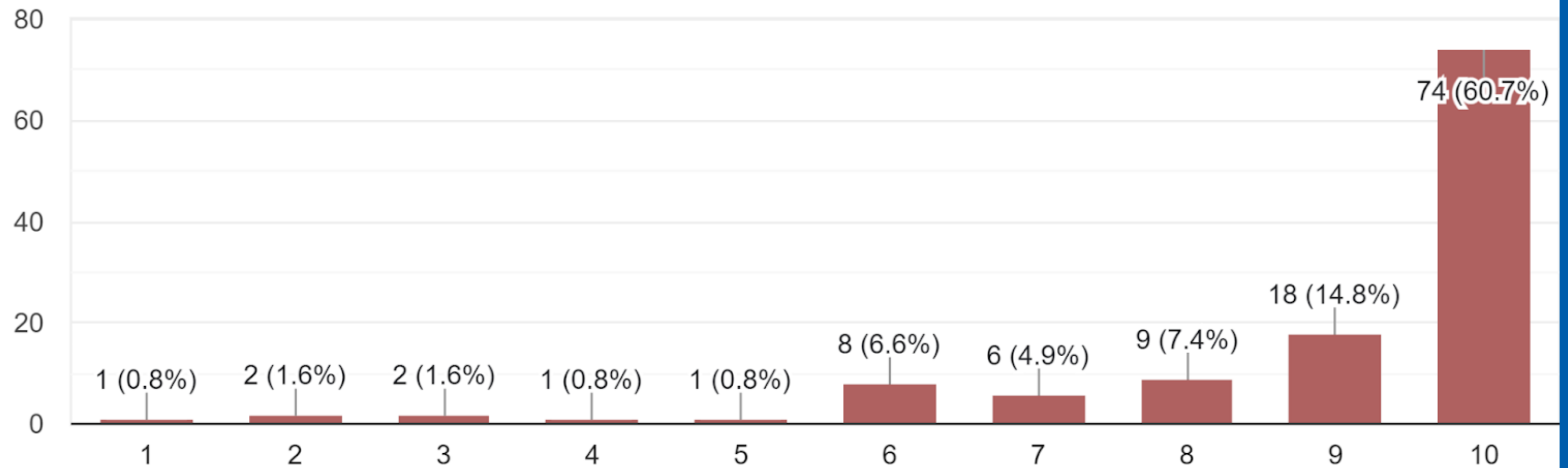

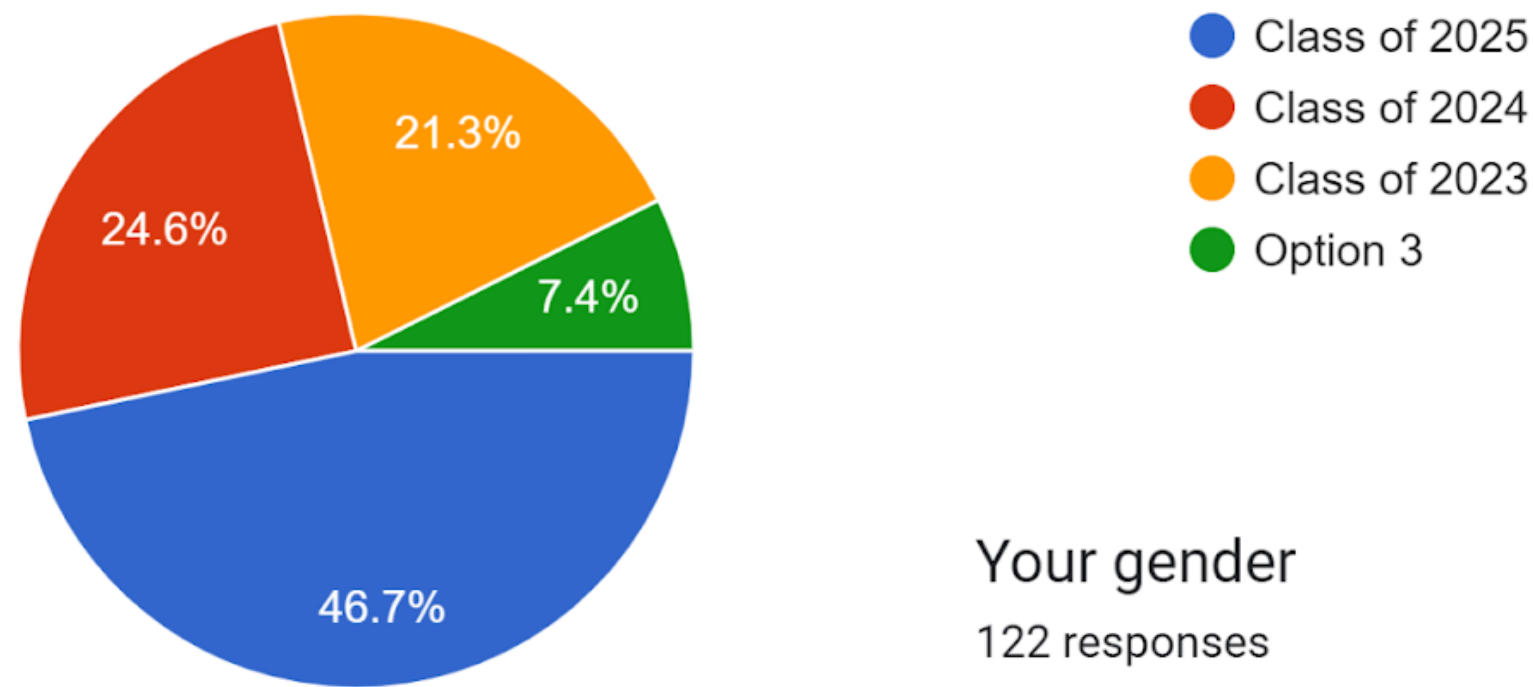


1 - Poor (Sometimes I think they were making it up as they went along.)
