Course evaluation (%): A – excellent: 100-93%, B – very good: 92-84%, C – good: 83-74%, D – satisfactory: 73-63%, E – sufficient: 62-51%, Fx – fail: 50-0%. Passing the course assumes that student was not absent at more than 4 class sessions.					
<b>Výsledky vzdelávania:</b> The objective of this course is to understand structures, principals, and procedures of the European Union. Students will be able to understand and answer questions such as: How can we understand the creation of EU? Who are the main actors of EU? What does EU do? To understand these questions, students will be reading primary sources, as well as European Treaties. In the course, we will focus on the current events and discourses inside EU. The ultimate objective of this course is to evaluation of the impacts european integration has on political and economic scene of Europe: Does EU strenghten or weaken the member states? Is EU the cause or the effect of of the peace inside Europe? Is there a tendency towards further integration or are we at the beginning of an era of disintegration?
