Late arrival is marked as a "tardie". Three tardies equal one absence. Missing more than 15 minutes of the class is considered an absence.</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Revisit and mobilize what we learned about Ancient Greeks a year ago</li> <li>-Learn how to focus on one thick and difficult philosophical classic</li> <li>-Learn to orient ourselves in the ten books of the Republic</li> <li>-Sketch the very element of Ancient Greek thought – get a 'total' picture of the times, as Marcel Mauss would put it</li> <li>-Practice the art of Platonic dialogue, i.e., discuss contemporary (sensitive) topics based on the rules that applied in Plato's Academy</li> <li>-Get critical, from the Ancient Greek perspective, on the limits and shortcomings of democracy in our times, based on the first experience of democracy (5 th and 4 th centuries BC)</li> </ul>
