<b>Podmienky na absolvovanie predmetu:</b> 10% Active attendance in seminars, preparedness for class, participation in discussions; 25% Weekly written assignments; 30% Final paper; 20% National elections simulation; 15% Short Seminar Presentation from selected text. Course evaluation (%): A – excellent: 100-93%, B – very good: 92-84%, C – good: 83-74%, D – satisfactory: 73-63%, E – sufficient: 62-51%, Fx – fail: 50-0%. Passing the course assumes that student was not absent at more than 4 class sessions. Late arrival is marked as a “tardie”. Three tardies equal one absence. Missing more than 15 minutes of the class is considered an absence.
