Podmienky na absolvovanie predmetu: Active participation based upon class readings is absolutely necessary and therefore accounts for thirty percent of the overall grade. Written reflections throughout the semester will account for ten percent of the overall grade. There will be two written examinations which will each account for ten percent of the overall grade. Each student will conduct an analysis-based research paper of at least 2,000 words and present their findings to the class; this will account for twenty-five percent of their overall grade. Each student will lead a seminar discussion over a particular chapter from the required reading which will account for the remaining fifteen percent of the grade. The grading scale is as follows: A – excellent: 100-93%; B – very good: 92-84%; C – good: 83-74%; D – satisfactory: 73-63%; E – sufficient: 62-51%; Fx – fail: 50-0%.

Výsledky vzdelávania: The aim of this course is to give students a deeper understanding of this region's history and provide some historical context for the contemporary political and philosophical writings that they may be asked to study in other courses at BISLA. This course will focus on Europe as a whole, while emphasizing regional variations as well as exceptions to generally regarded rules of homogeneity. Students will be asked to consider the perspective and motivations of various actors (individuals, groups, nations, or alliances) and to assess the value of different historical sources and approaches to writing history. Along with increased historical understanding, students will cultivate better critical thinking and analytical skills that can be applied in a range of academic and practical settings.
