Podmienky na absolvovanie predmetu: This intensive seminar prepares students for the full Bachelor Thesis course by guiding them through the essential early stages of thesis development. Because the course lasts only five weeks, the emphasis is on building the structural foundations of the thesis rather than producing polished content. By the end of the seminar, students are expected to have a working thesis title and a short annotation/abstract that clearly expresses the research focus. Course evaluation (%): A – excellent: 100-93%, B – very good: 92-84%, C – good: 83-74%, D – satisfactory: 73-63%, E – sufficient: 62-51%, Fx – fail: 50-0%. Passing the course assumes that the student was not absent at more than 1 class sessions. Late arrival is marked as a “tardie”. Three tardies equal one absence. Missing more than 15 minutes of the class is considered an absence.

-Develop the macro-structure of the thesis (overall outline and logic). -Practice micro-structural writing through short assignments and draft chapters. -Learn to incorporate academic sources effectively. -Engage in peer review and seminar discussions. -Prepare a formal Bachelor Thesis Proposal. -Gain experience presenting and defending early research ideas.
